ST. PATRICK'S DAY PARADE 2019

The largest single-day spectator event in the State of Connecticut, the Greater New Haven St. Patrick's Day Parade, steps off at 1:30 P.M, on Sunday, March 10, 2019, in downtown New Haven

The 2019 Parade will travel the traditional route, beginning on Chapel Street at Sherman Avenue, and ending on Grove Street at Orange Street. The Parade route travels Southeast on Chapel Street, to the end of the Green, where it turns left onto Church Street. It follows Church Street to Grove Street, where it turns right, and ends at Orange Street. The Parade Route is 1.5 miles.
