TAFT – VACCINE SITE, MAY 4th

In connection with Griffin Hospital and the New Haven Health Department, we are excited to host a vaccine site in The Taft Grand Lobby on Tuesday, May 4th from 11am – 5pm. Please note that this is for New Haven Residents 18 and older, and no appointments are required.

FIRE ALARM TESTING

On Tuesday, May 11th, from 9am – 3pm, The Taft will be conducting its annual Fire Alarm Testing. Please note that we are required to sound all fire alarm horns during one part of the test. The fire alarm horns will all be sounded for a short period of time in order to allow the technicians from Johnson Controls to ensure that each fire alarm horn & strobe light is working properly. When you hear the alarms sound during the test period only, it is not necessary to leave the building. At all other times, always leave the building and call 911.

SHOW OFF YOUR MASK

Please do your part to keep our common areas safe. As recommended by the CDC and stated by the City of New Haven Health Department, **you must wear a cloth face covering when you are in our common areas.** Masks, bandanas, and even scarves can be helpful in our effort to keep the hallways, elevators, Laundry Center, and Grand Lobby safe for the entire Taft community. We also ask that Residents & Guests use the elevators one-household at a time in order to maintain a proper social distance. Your understanding and cooperation is vital to the health of our community.
